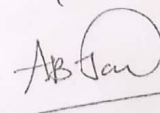

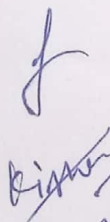
ORDER

The order dated 19.05.2022 passed by the Hon'ble High Court in C.M No.4021-LPA-2017 in/and LPA No.1865 of 2017 Housing Board Haryana, C.M No.4032-LPA-2017 in/and LPA No.1870 of 2017 (O &M) and CWP No.16880 of 2020 titled Yatindra Kumar Gupta and Ors. Vs. State of Haryana and Ors. were challenged by Housing Board Haryana in the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India through Petition(S) for Special Leave to Appeal (C) No.(s). 14826/2022, SLP (C) No.15235-15236/2022 (IV-B) and SLP (C) No.15073-15074 (IV-B) for restoration of notification dated 28.01.2020 by Housing Board Haryana. The Hon'ble Apex Court dismissed the SLPs vide order dated 19.09.2022 filed by the Housing Board Haryana with the directions that the retired employees of appellant are entitled to medical reimbursement at par with the State Government employees and the in-service employees of the Board in view of the Clause 7 of the appointment letter wherein it was provided that "the employees of the Board are governed by the rules applicable to the Haryana Government employees". Further, the Hon'ble Apex Court has also cited the provision of Regulation 13 of the Haryana Housing Board (Recruitment & Conditions of Service of officers and Employees) Regulations, 2006 whereby it has been stated that in respect of pay, leaves and other matters not provided in the regulations, the employees of the Board shall be governed by the corresponding rules of the State Government.

Therefore, in view of the above, the Housing Board Haryana has decided to implement the order dated 19.05.2022 passed by Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court, Chandigarh for compliance in letter and spirit.
